The Department of Labor ("DOL") requires retirement plan sponsors to provide specific planrelated information to all eligible employees of qualified retirement plans. This document serves as your participant plan-related information disclosure for the Publix Super Markets, Inc. 401(k) SMART Plan ("SMART Plan").

1. Explanation of the circumstances under which participants and beneficiaries may give investment instructions:

The SMART Plan requires all plan participants, including beneficiaries of deceased participants and Qualified Domestic Relations Order ("QDRO") alternate payees, to direct the investment of their individual savings contribution and matching contribution accounts, if applicable. Plan participants can choose to invest their accounts among 10 asset classes offering 12 investment fund options. For more information on the investment fund options offered under the SMART Plan, please see the Comparative Chart of Investment Fund Options.

You can review and change the allocation of your SMART Plan account balances among the investment fund options at any time by visiting the SMART Plan website at https://publix401k.voya.com or calling the SMART Plan Information Line toll-free at 1-888-401k-PLN (1-888-401-5756). Customer service associates are available through the Information Line Monday through Friday, 8 a.m. to 8 p.m., Eastern Time (except on stock market holidays) to offer assistance. You will need your username and password to access your online account.

2. Explanation of specific limitations on participant-directed investment instructions, including restrictions on transfers to or from a specific investment fund option:

Publix Stock Fund

The Publix Stock Fund is made up of two components: shares of Publix Stock and cash awaiting investment in Publix Stock. Plan participants can choose to direct up to 25% of their contributions to the Publix Stock Fund.

All transactions which require the buying or selling of Publix Stock are held and are only processed on Publix Stock valuation effective dates, which are generally March 1, May 1, August 1 and November 1 (or the first business day thereafter). Any transactions received on or after the valuation effective date are held and processed on the next valuation effective date. These transactions include associate contributions, employer matching contributions, reinvested dividends and earnings, loan repayments, withdrawals, distributions and fund transfers out of the Publix Stock Fund.

You can choose to initiate a transfer out of the Publix Stock portion of the Publix Stock Fund on any day you wish, but the transaction will "pend" (wait) for processing until the next valuation effective date, which is generally March 1, May 1, August 1 or November 1 (or the first business day thereafter). Pending fund transfers for Publix Stock will remain in effect until processed on the next valuation effective date or until you initiate a subsequent fund transfer. Fund transfers to the Publix Stock Fund are prohibited.

Any cash awaiting investment in Publix Stock is available to you for fund transfers, loans, withdrawals or distributions.

3. Description of the exercise of voting, tender and similar rights associated with an investment in an investment fund option, including any restrictions on such rights:

Plan participants do not have any voting, tender or similar rights associated with investments in the investment fund options offered under the SMART Plan.

5. Explanation of any fees for general administrative services (for example, legal, accounting, recordkeeping fees) that may be charged against or deducted from individual participants' SMART Plan accounts, including the basis on which such fees are allocated:

Former Publix associates, beneficiaries of deceased participants and QDRO alternate payees are charged a quarterly administrative fee. This fee is assessed by the SMART Plan on March 1, May 1, August 1 and November 1 (or the first business day thereafter) if the plan participant has account balances on these dates. The quarterly fee is \$7.50, which is based on the per participant administrative fee paid by Publix to the recordkeeper, Voya Institutional Plan Services ("Voya"), for maintaining the participants' SMART Plan accounts for the previous calendar quarter.

The quarterly administrative fee is deducted pro-rata from participants' accounts based on the dollar value of the non-Publix stock investments as of 4 p.m., Eastern Time on the business day prior to March 1, May 1, August 1 or November 1, as applicable. If there are insufficient non-Publix stock investments to cover the quarterly administrative fee, the remaining fee is deducted from the participant's Publix Stock holdings.

For current Publix associates, Publix pays the quarterly administrative fee. Publix also pays the quarterly administrative fees not collected from the accounts of former participants who received distributions of their entire account balances.

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¹ The cash awaiting investment in Publix Stock under the Publix Stock Fund is invested in the State Street Institutional U.S. Government Money Market Fund – Premier Class. See disclosure item 2 for restrictions on the Publix Stock Fund.

6. Explanation of any fees and expenses that can be charged against or deducted from individual participants' SMART Plan accounts rather than on a plan-wide basis:

Additional fees will be deducted from your individual SMART Plan accounts if you elect certain transactions under the plan.

If you elect to take out a loan against your SMART Plan accounts, you will be charged a loan request fee of \$100.00, and Florida residents will be charged a Florida documentary stamp tax of \$0.35 per \$100.00 borrowed.

If you elect to receive loan proceeds or a withdrawal or distribution check using overnight mail delivery, you will be charged an overnight mail fee of \$25.00.

When these transaction fees apply under the SMART Plan, you will receive a confirmation statement from Voya disclosing the fees. You also can review these fees on your quarterly participant statement.
